Use these discussion starters to help foster a spiritual conversation with your family.

CONNECTION POINT: People should value and love others like God loves them.

THE BIBLE MEETS LIFE: Anyone can be nice, and the world applauds random acts of kindness. Random acts of kindness are a good thing, but they are not enough. It's easy to be nice and kind when we feel like it, but the needs of others are not always convenient. Intentional Love

STUDENTS

THE POINT: Go out of your way to love others.

- When has someone gone out of their way to do something really nice for you?
- What's the connection between loving God and loving others? Can we do one without the other?
- When has your love for God prompted you to love other people?
- In what ways do we sometimes justify not helping others in need?
- When has someone taken risks or made sacrifices to demonstrate God's love to you?

LIVE IT OUT: Your student has been encouraged to take practical steps to take his or her faith and Live It Out in the Personal Study Guide.

Here are some ways you can encourage your students to live out their faith with Christ personally, in community, and in their culture:

- **CHRIST:** Discuss with your student ways that Jesus may be leading him or her. Take time to pray together for the strength to listen and follow.
- **COMMUNITY:** How can your family develop deeper relationships within your church family?
- **CULTURE:** Talk with your student about people he or she knows that are not Christians. How can he or she care for them in a way that points to Christ?
