1. Conversation Starter

Question: What thing(s) from this book shock you? What does this tell you about God's character?

2. Digging Deeper

In today's sermon, we looked at five truths about God's love from the book of Hosea. Which one stood out to you?

How does this book point us to Jesus? (See Hosea 3:4-5)

Read Hosea 4:1-6, then Hosea 6:1-6. What do you learn about God in these passages? Why do you learn about yourself? Where do we find hope?

Read and reflect on Hosea 11:8

3. Share with the Group

What makes you unlovable? How does it make you feel to know that God still send His Son for you even though you're that unlovable?

In this book, God asked Hosea to love someone who would be difficult to love. How does God's love help us to love those who seem unlovable?

How does this book give us hope for people we know that are far from God? How can that help us relate to people who are far from God?

4. Take Action

How have you been unfaithful to God this week? Take some time on your own to confess your sin and ask God for strength to turn from that unfaithfulness.

Who in your life needs to hear the redemption story of Hosea? Write their name down and commit to praying for them this week.
