Use these discussion starters to help foster a spiritual conversation with your family.

**CONNECTION POINT:** People should love, forgive, and pray for their family members.

**THE BIBLE MEETS LIFE:** The majority of churches in America are not closed to outsiders; they want other people to visit and even get involved. But extending a sincere welcome to those who visit is not enough, because most people never come to the church building. Instead, the church is to go where people are and extend the invitation. ## STUDENTS

**THE POINT:** Engaging others with the gospel means going where they are.

- When have you been thankful God told you “no”?
- When have you felt a sense of guidance from the Holy Spirit?
- What are some ways God communicates His will to Christians today?
- When have you sensed God’s prompting to share the gospel with someone?
- How would you describe God’s part and our part in leading others to Christ?
- What are some creative ways you’ve seen others share the gospel?

**LIVE IT OUT:** Your student has been encouraged to take practical steps to take his or her faith and Live It Out in the Personal Study Guide.

*Here are some ways you can encourage your students to live out their faith with Christ personally, in community, and in their culture:*

- **CHRIST:** Ask your student what things may be preventing him or her from pursuing Christ fully.
- **COMMUNITY:** Encourage your student to reach out to people that do not know the gospel. Invite him or her to work alongside other students to pursue the lost.
- **CULTURE:** Consider ways you can share the gospel message in your community and beyond. How can your family make a difference and reach the lost?
